- about 30 tutors in after school facilities;
- > 14 lay religion teachers;
- > 13 ONG workers,
- about 45 lay people who support our ministry;
- about 120 volunteers
- and students and parents...

CALASANTIAN SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF PIARIST SCHOOLS' TEACHERS

The documents of the Piarist Order set 4 ways of belonging to it:

- 1. Cooperation
- 2. Participation
- 3. Charismatic integration
- 4. Charismatic and legal integration

CALASANTIAN SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF PIARIST SCHOOLS' TEACHERS

Each school puts forward a program for a year which consists of:

- Celebration of Eucharist in school's chapel
- Prayer Days during the school year
- Spiritual gatherings
- Liturgical celebrations
- Trips and pilgrimages

On Calasantian Day, Calasantian Letter is addressed to all provincial communities to awaken afterthought. It also presents prayer intentions.

HOLIDAY RETREAT

They are organised yearly, during summer holidays by the Province.

- 1st level retreat- they are aimed at people who take part in the retreat for the first time. They consider Calasantian tutor's features based on st. Joseph Calasanz
- 2nd level retreat- their subject of consideration changes every year. Those subjects refer to Christian life, spirituality and Calasantian pedagogy
- 3rd level retreat- (focus on different subjects) They are aimed at those who participated the former levels and want to focus and develop more in silence.

Not only Piarist collaborates can participate in the 1st and 2nd level retreat but also their spouses and children. In such a way it can be a family experience. Only adults can participate in the 3rd level retreat.

SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT OF LAITY SECRETARY

Tasks of the Secretary:

- Preparation of yearly retreat for lay people working in Piarist institutions,
- Working out and inspecting Calasantian Spiritual Development Program for Lay Collaborates, including creation of Pious Schools Brotherhood,
- Preparation of Calasantian Spiritual Development Program for Tutors in Day Care Institutions, association workers, foundations and clubs workers taking into consideration the uniqueness of each of the institutions,
- Writing Spiritual Development of Lay Statute,
- Preparing Piarist lay leaders and including them into spiritual development processes,
- Organising current events for lay people.
 - Due to the differences in processes of spiritual development among lay Piarist collaborates, which result from the character of their involvement, two separate secretaries were brought into being by Provincial Father:
- secretary dealing with laity involved in formal education and
 - secretary dealing with laity involved in non-formal education)

Both lay people and monks are members of these secretaries.

LAITY MEETINGS

Piarist Laity Meetings are aimed at lay people who cooperate in Piarist actions in order to enrich them spiritually and develop the Piarist pedagogy.

Laity Meetings held so far:

1st Laity Meeting – Warsaw 2009.

Motto: "Two vocations- one mission"

2nd Laity Meeting – Sulejówek 2012.

Motto: "You did not choose me, no, I chose you" John 15,16.

The major purpose of this meeting was to show the participants what Piarist Faith Communities are and their development path. Thus Constanza from Valencia and Patxi from Emaus – two lay people from Pious Schools Brotherhood, participated in the meeting 3rd Piarist Laity Meeting 2014- autumn.













LAITY FEASTS

They are a chance to:

- establish bounds among people involved in Piarist actions
- exchange experiences and discuss about important pedagogical issues
- pray together for the Piarist teachers and students
- enjoy each other, experience community and continue st. Calasanz work
- Laity Feast Warsaw, 27 October 2007. 174 representants from most of Piarist institutions in Poland participated. The meeting product was establishing seven features of lay Piar:
 - We are called to bring up and educate according to the spirit of Gospel.
 - We are aware of our vocation and we want to follow our Master Jesus and his faithful follower Calasanz.
 - We are open to others needs and we share our love and faith.
 - We bring the youth up to become responsible for the Country.
 - We practice the Calasantian charisma remembering about the vocation to live in a family
 - We wish to support each other by exchanging experiences and integration
- Laity Feast 2010 in Warsaw- 177 teachers and Piarist workers participated. They Discussed how Polish Piarist Fathers can pass the Piarist charism to they lay people.
- Laity Feast 2013 "Religious and lay people witnesses of faith in education",
 Piarist Lay people from Austria, Czech Republic, Slovakia and Hungary participated.








